Introduction

The Public Involvement Plan (PIP) outlines the procedures that will be used to engage the public during the update of the City of Ontario's Active Transportation System Plan (TSP) and East Idaho Avenue Refinement Area Plan. The PIP will be used as a guide for the City of Ontario, Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT), and Kittelson & Associates to incorporate the public outreach activities and make decisions that will be incorporated into the final Report.

Purpose

The purpose of the PIP is to actively gather public input, share information, and identify priority areas that potentially affect the users of the City of Ontario's Transportation System. The PIP has setup public user groups comprised of residents, active community members, property owners, businesses, local associations, and public agencies.

Schedule

The PIP schedule for each community activity was incorporated into the Project Schedule that was presented at PMT Meeting #1. The schedule was setup to allow for continual involvement from the public through the duration of the project. Refer to the attached Project Schedule. The Community Activities have been highlighted in yellow. Due to recent COVID19 government restrictions, the Project Management Team decided to extend the schedule by 4 weeks and are planning to begin Community Outreach Activities in May 2020. The PIP activities will be announced through fliers, City of Ontario TSP webpage, Argus Observer, City Facebook page, Chamber of Commerce, school announcements, and other community newsletters.



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The Community Meetings will be held at the Four Rivers Cultural Center & Museum in the City of Ontario. It is at a central location and has a large meeting area which is typical used for other Community Meetings. The address is 676 SW 5th Ave., Ontario, OR.

Public Groups

The public involvement groups and group activities are listed below. The City of Ontario worked together with ODOT to select the members for the Stakeholder and Technical Advisory Committee (TAC). Refer to the attached Stakeholder and TAC member list.

- Community members: Includes active residents and is open to all members of the public. Activities
 include 1 community workshop and 2 community open house meetings.
- Stakeholders: Includes up to 50 members from a variety of local community groups, associations, and city and state agencies. Activities include (1) community workshop and (2) community open house meetings. Twenty-eight of the fifty stakeholders invited have confirmed attended the meeting. The City is still awaiting response from some invitees.
- Technical Advisory Committee (TAC): Includes up to 16 members from a variety of agency, community organizations, and individuals with special interests to the project. Activities will include (4) meetings. Thirteen of the sixteen members on the list have confirmed attendance.

Workshops

In addition, the PIP will incorporate (2) Community Online Works shops and (2) Youth group workshops. The youth group workshops will be held with a 5th Grade Class in an Elementary School and High School. The focus of the Youth Group Workshops is to have students help provide input and options for developing the Safe Routes to School Program (SRTS).

Additional Public Outreach

Currently, the City of Ontario Oregon's website has a Transportation System Plan page where the City is actively posting relevant information about the TSP. The public is encouraged to visit the site to read a detailed description of the project, project objectives, timeline, and meeting updates. Prior TSP reports are also available to read on this page for residents to get a better understanding of the existing transportation systems and previous recommendations which can be used to provide input at Community meetings and workshops. The webpage is also interactive, allowing readers to sign up for email reminders and also enable them to submit a public comment without having to attend a meeting.

Disclaimer

The City of Ontario is aware of the COVID-19 pandemic and is focused on ensuring the safety of residents and City Staff. One of the main goals of the PIP is to obtain input from the public about various areas of transportation improvements that the City should focus on. While the social distancing guidelines may inhibit the type of meetings and workshops that can be held, it will not deny the public their right to provide



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input. The City is actively looking into virtual meeting alternatives and additional ways that the public can provide their input. Updates on meeting information will be posted on the City website and will be sent via email to those who have signed up for email updates. The City will also coordinate with the local youth groups to develop alternative Youth Group Workshops if in-person activities are not plausible or if the local school district do not return for the Spring 2020 semester.
