PROVISIONAL COMMERCIAL GENERAL CONTRACTOR LEVEL 2

WHO: Oregon Construction Contractors Board

WHAT: Proposed concept to create rules to address concerns about an insufficient number of licensed contractors to perform repair work to commercial buildings damaged by extreme weather in Malheur County by waiving the pre-license training and exam

WHERE: Licensed contractors from Arizona, California, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, Utah, and Washington would be eligible for this provisional license to perform work in Malheur County only

WHEN: Provisional licenses issued under these rules would be valid for two years from the date of issuance, and would not be eligible for renewal

If these rules are implemented, the requirements for this provisional license would be:

1. Documentation that the applicant is currently licensed in one of the specified bordering states
2. The contractor has four or more years of construction experience
3. A surety bond of at least \$20,000 issued by a bonding agency that is authorized to do business in Oregon
4. Liability insurance of at least \$1 million aggregate issued by an insurance agency that is authorized to do business in Oregon
5. Appropriate workers' compensation insurance
6. The business name has been registered to conduct business in Oregon with the Secretary of State's office
7. Submit the application and licensing fee of \$325 with the above documentation
