<p>Have an Infant? Here is what you need to do:</p> <p>Use a rear-facing car seat to at least age 1 and 20 lbs. Use your rear-facing car seat longer if the seat has higher weight and height limits. <a href="#">Learn More &gt;&gt;</a></p>	<p>Have a toddler? Here is what you need to know:</p> <p>Use a forward-facing car seat (convertible or combo seat) until the harness no longer fits. <a href="#">Learn More &gt;&gt;</a></p>	<p>Have a booster kid? Here is what you need to know:</p> <p>Use a booster seat with the vehicle lap and shoulder safety belts until your child passes the Safety Belt Fit Test. <a href="#">Learn More &gt;&gt;</a></p>	<p>Have a Safety Belt Kid? Here is what you need to do:</p> <p>Once your child passes the Safety Belt Fit Test, make it a rule to use a safety belt in a back seat on every ride. <a href="#">Learn More &gt;&gt;</a></p>

<p>Never let a child ride unrestrained</p>	<p>Never use a pillows, books, towels or other objects to boost a child</p>	<p>Never use a child safety seat that has been in a crash, or if you don't know the history of the seat</p>	<p>Never position a shoulder belt under a child's arm or behind the back</p>

Volunteers will be on hand to assist you in finding out if your car seat is properly installed, if you have the correct car seat for your child's age & weight or if your car seat is on a current re-call list.  
Plan approximately 30 minutes and you must have the child with you when attending.
