



Fall Cleanup Program

The City of Ontario's annual Fall Cleanup Program is scheduled the week before Thanksgiving (November 13-17, 2017). Citizens may place leaves, branches, garden plants, and other yard debris on the curbside and City crews will come by and pick it up. To participate in this program, residents need to bag, box, or bundle their leaves and yard debris and place them on the curb. This is to prevent them from blowing around in the street and eventually blocking drainage basins. It is also requested that residents limit the weight of each bag, box or bundle to 50 pounds as maintenance crews physically lift each bag into a loader bucket or dump truck.

Maintenance crews will go through the town Monday - Friday. Please have the debris on the curb side on **Monday the 13th** so it is not missed as we go through the town. The refuse is taken to a landfill and ground into compost; therefore, batteries, tires and other refuse, which will not decompose **will not** be picked up.
