



Transportation Plan Update

The City of Ontario has been hard at work in the development of both the Active Transportation Plan and the East Idaho Avenue Refinement Plan to make transportation across the city better for everyone – people of all ages and abilities walking, biking, taking public transit, and driving. The project team has developed a vision, goals, and objectives, held stakeholder and technical advisory committee meetings, completed city-wide land use and transportation assessments, completed GIS mapping, recorded traffic count data, produced technical memoranda, and conducted community engagement efforts.

As part of these efforts, the City invited the public to participate in an Online Open House that was open for 3 weeks, from June 2nd to June 19th. Participants learned about the two plans and provided their initial feedback. Comments and suggestions received from the Open House will be used to develop the transportation solutions that will be presented in the plans.
