

BURNING PERMIT

ONTARIO RURAL FIRE DISTRICT #7-302

In accordance to ORS Chapters 476.380 to 478.960, and the International Fire Code Chapter 3, permit for burning has been issued to:

This permit is valid for an OPEN BURN / BURN BARREL from _____ to _____ (30 day max for open burns) during daylight hours and under the following conditions only:

1. There shall be a minimum 10' clearance maintained between any burning container or pile and any property lines, fences, buildings, trees, shrubs, or other combustibles.
2. Materials to be burned shall be organic and dry, NO garbage, NO plastics, NO rubber or other man-made materials.
3. Burn shall be continuously attended by an able bodied person with a garden hose or sufficient firefighting equipment*.
**Firefighting equipment and personnel sufficient to control the fire shall be present continually at the burn site until fire is extinguished. (ie: garden hose, sprayer, tractor & disc, fire extinguisher(s), shovel(s))*
4. All fires must be extinguished at dusk or before left unattended.
5. Field and or open burns shall have a fire lane disced enclosing the entire burn area before ignition.
6. Burn Barrels shall have a wire mesh top screen of 1/2" and be on bare ground with no combustibles within 10 feet.
7. All Burning shall stop if winds increase up to 15 MPH, and/or the air temperature exceeds 90 degrees F, and/or burning emits noxious smoke.
8. Notification shall be given prior to burning near any BLM ground (within 1 mile) by calling Vale BLM at (541) 473-6295.
9. If large amount of smoke and/or fire are expected, please call Fire Department personnel before burning at (541) 881-3233 or dispatch at (541) 473-5125.

I agree to conform to all applicable County and State regulations in regards to this burn, and assume total responsibility for the safe and proper execution.

I understand that I may personally be held liable for any costs of suppression and/or damage to other property if I fail to control this burn, in addition to criminal citations and penalties.
