## What is a System Development Charge (SDC)?

The City Council adopted System Development Charges (SDCs) and the methodology for establishing the fees in 2008. SDCs are govemed by ORS 223.297. The fees collected are used for capital improvements to increase city-wide capacities for water, sewer and transportation.

## SDC smay be collected when:

$\checkmark$ New orexpanded development occurs.
$\checkmark$ There is a change of use oroccupancy.
$\checkmark$ Additional dwelling units are added.
$\checkmark$ Water meter size is inc rea sed.

## Who Calculates the fees and for what?

$\checkmark$ Development Services Department collects three types of SDCs (water, wastewater and transportation) to offset the impact that new development has on public infrastructure.

## Who colect the fees?

$\checkmark$ Planning Technician - SDC fees must be collected prior to issuing a building permit.

How do Iappeal an SDC Fee?

- Ontario Municipal Code (OMC) 8-13-13(b) Challenges and Appeals states the following: Any person may appeal to the council any decision of the Administrator made pursuant to this Ordinance by filing a written request with the Administrator within 10 days after the delivery of the Administrator's written decision to the applicant.

The City of Ontario can also provide you with an estimate of your SDCs. An application is available at the Pemit Center.

## SDC Facts

$\checkmark$ On July 21, 2008, the City Council adopted Ordinance 2618-2008 allowing the creation of SDCs. On September 3, 2008, the City Council adopted Resolution 2008-146 which establishes SDC fees for water, wastewater and transportation.
$\checkmark$ SDCs are collected at the time a building permit is issued.
$\checkmark$ SDCs must be paid in full prior to filing an appeal if you disagree with the fees collected.
$\checkmark$ SDCs can only be used to fund increased system capacities.
